Federal Sovereign of 1542 Est. Mendocino, California, 1856 Est. Mendocino Indian Reservation, Mendocino, California. Tribes exist in Mendocino County since time immemorial. Lineal and aboriginal indigenous peoples have lived on their land in organized societies and districts with traditional cultures and their own forms of autonomous sovereign government that predates the United States of America or its interior and Mendocino, California.

This AGREEMENT provides framework for the establishment of lasting government-to-government relationships and in implementation of ATN policies and procedures to assure that such relationships are constructive and meaningful and further enhance cooperation between all parties.

Each party to this AGREEMENT acknowledges the sovereignty of the others. The parties share respect for the values and cultures of Mendocino Indian Reserve Indigenous peoples. Further, the parties share a desire for an agreement between ATN and the Tribes that reflects a full government-to-government relationship.

The parties desire that this AGREEMENT between ATN Tribal Contractor and the Tribal Government Services are strong enough to withstand the test of time and ensure fair treatment of both the Tribal Government Services and the Mendocino Reserve.

Each party to this AGREEMENT acknowledges ATN is a unique government with different management, distinct customs, traditions, practices values and decision-making structures.

The Tribal Nations Government is organized into three branches of government: Tribal Advisory Committee (TAC), Tribal Business Department (TBD) and judicial Chief Justice. The executive branch is divided into principal TAC, TBD, and FEMA departments under the authority of the Head Chief.

Each party to this AGREEMENT acknowledges all resolutions combined to ATN are in effect and updated.

**PURPOSE:**

The purpose of tribal agreement , also referred to as Memorandums of Understanding (MOUs) is to clarify roles, and responsibilities and to enhance coordination and cooperation between the tribal governments of Small Agencies, Departments, American Indian organizations, 37 states, federally recognized tribes and Children's Administration (MC) MENDOCINO CALIFORNIA in providing appropriate Hemp and Cannabis Licensing.

Under Executive Order 13175, "Consultation and Coordination with Indian Tribal Governments," and USDA Departmental Regulation 1350-002 "Tribal Consultation, Coordination, and Collaboration," USDA aims to respect Indian tribal self-government and sovereignty, honor tribal treaty and other rights, and meet the responsibilities that arise from the unique legal relationship between the Federal government and Tribal governments. Because duly elected tribal leaders, or their designee, trigger the government-to-government relationship with the United States, formal administrative requirements under the Federal Advisory Committee Act do not apply.<sup>1</sup>
