Dear Tribal Leader,

We are writing regarding the implementation of the recently enacted Anti-Money Laundering Act of 2020 (AML Act) by the Financial Crimes Enforcement Network (FinCEN).<sup>1</sup> As you may know, FinCEN is a bureau of the U.S. Department of the Treasury whose mission is to safeguard the financial system from illicit use, combat money laundering, and promote national security through the strategic use of financial authorities and the collection, analysis, and dissemination of financial intelligence.

The AML Act includes significant reforms to the U.S. anti-money laundering regulatory regime, and the Act requires consultation and enhanced partnership between FinCEN and Tribal governmental agencies in implementing several of the Act's reforms.

We are sending this letter to highlight issues that may be relevant to you, to invite you to participate in a meeting focused on some of these changes, and to encourage your participation in FinCEN's rulemaking and other implementation efforts, as described in more detail below.

The following sections of the AML Act call for engagement between FinCEN and Tribal authorities:

1. **Corporate Transparency Act.** Title LXIV (Sections 6401-6403) of the AML Act is known as the Corporate Transparency Act (CTA). The CTA mandates FinCEN's collection of beneficial ownership information from certain legal entities formed or registered to do business in the United States, including those formed or registered by filing the appropriate forms under Tribal law. The CTA also provides for FinCEN's disclosure of beneficial ownership information to authorized users, including Tribal law enforcement, pursuant to security, confidentiality, and use protocols. In promulgating regulations requiring the reporting of beneficial ownership information, the Secretary of the Treasury must, to the greatest extent practicable, establish partnerships with State, local, and Tribal government agencies and work collaboratively with these agencies to update the required reporting information. Relevant Federal, State, and Tribal agencies are required, to the greatest extent practicable and consistent with applicable protections, to cooperate with and provide information to FinCEN for purposes of maintaining an accurate, complete, and highly useful database of beneficial ownership information. The CTA also requires Tribal organizations to provide certain notifications to those who form or register legal entities.
2. **AML Act Section 6102(b).** This provision amends FinCEN's duties and powers under 31 U.S.C. § 310(b)(2) to expand information sharing with Tribal authorities.
3. **AML Act Section 6306.** This provision adds a new safe harbor to protect financial institutions from liability or supervisory action for keeping a customer account open or maintaining a transaction in response to a written request from a law enforcement agency (*i.e.*, a "keep open request"), so long as, in the case of non-Federal law enforcement agencies, including Tribal

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law enforcement, FinCEN concurs with the request. After issuing the written request, the law enforcement agency must submit a copy to FinCEN and alert FinCEN as to whether the financial institution has implemented the request. This provision requires the Secretary of the Treasury, in consultation with the Attorney General and Federal, State, Tribal, and local law enforcement agencies, to issue guidance on the required elements of a keep open request.

4. **AML Act Section 6307.** This provision requires all federal examiners reviewing compliance with the Bank Secrecy Act to attend annual training regarding anti-money laundering and countering the financing of terrorism. The Secretary of the Treasury, in consultation with the Financial Institutions Examinations Council, FinCEN, and Federal, State, Tribal, and local law enforcement agencies, must establish appropriate training materials and standards for use in the required training.

We anticipate various opportunities for Tribal organization consultation and engagement regarding FinCEN's efforts to implement these provisions, starting with the following:

1. **Virtual Meeting.** We invite you to participate in a virtual meeting on Wednesday, April 21, 2021 from 2:00 p.m. to 4:00 p.m. EST. We respectfully request that each tribe register one primary leader or designee leader to provide comments. Others are welcome to register as listen-only participants. Please register [here](#).

This meeting will focus on the CTA. The goal of this meeting is to learn more about Tribal-specific processes, issues, and concerns related to the CTA, including business formation, registration, and ongoing compliance; transmission of relevant data to and from FinCEN, including any relevant technological issues that should be considered; and the best methods for future Tribal engagement with FinCEN, including how best to communicate and disseminate information.

2. **Rulemaking.** FinCEN has published an Advance Notice of Proposed Rulemaking ([ANPRM](#)) to solicit public comment on questions relevant to the implementation of the CTA, including the promulgation of regulations. Written comments on the ANPRM should be submitted to [regulations.gov](#) by May 5, 2021. We strongly encourage you to submit written comments in response to the ANPRM and in future stages of the rulemaking processes, so your views can be considered as FinCEN develops its regulations.
3. **Consultation on AML Act Sections 6306 and 6307.** There will be subsequent communications from Treasury regarding consultation on AML Act Sections 6306 and 6307 requirements.
4. **Broader engagement.** We intend to engage in dialogue with Tribal governmental agencies generally on how to strengthen our partnership, including appropriate sharing of financial



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intelligence maintained by FinCEN. We encourage you to reach out to FinCEN directly as we continue thinking through the opportunities to deepen the partnership between FinCEN and Tribal authorities. SUBJECT: Rescission of All Agency Memorandum No. 212

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All Agency Memorandum (AAM) No. 212, dated March 22, 2013, addressed the applicability of Davis-Bacon labor standards to members of survey crews. Since the issuance of AAM 212, concerns have been raised that this guidance was issued without a sufficiently broad appreciation of the coverage issue it addressed, especially with respect to identifying the duties performed by, and training required of, survey crew members who perform work immediately prior to and during construction, in direct support of construction crews. Delay in implementing AAM 212, while providing an opportunity for such concerns to be raised, has caused further confusion for the regulated community. In particular, section 15e20 of the Field Operations Handbook (FOH) was not revised as provided for in the AAM and the Wage and Hour Division's implementation of this guidance remains incomplete. Accordingly, AAM 212 is rescinded effective immediately. This rescission is consistent with Executive Order 13891, *Promoting the Rule of Law Through Improved Agency Guidance Documents*.

*Tribal Law & Order Act "25 CFR 11.104" Tribal Government law The Tribal Law and Order Act of 2010 is a law, signed into effect by President Barack Obama, that expands the punitive abilities of tribal courts across the nation. The law allows tribal courts operating in Indian country to increase jail sentences handed down in criminal cases over Indian offenders. This was a major step toward improving enforcement and justice in Indian country—and a precursor to VAWA 2013. The purposes of the Tribal Law and Order Act are to: • Clarify the responsibilities of the federal, state, tribal, and local governments with respect to crimes in Indian Country; • Increase coordination and communication among federal, state, tribal, and local law enforcement agencies; • Empower tribal governments with the authority, resources, and information necessary to safely and effectively provide public safety in Indian Country; • ILOC Report: A Road map For Making Native America Safer The Indian Law and Order Commission released its final report and recommendations—A Road map For Making Native America Safer—as required by the Tribal Law and Order Act of 2010. These recommendations are intended to make Native American and Alaska Native nations safer and more just for all U.S. citizens and to reduce the unacceptably high rates of violent crime that have plagued Indian country for decades. This report reflects one of the most comprehensive assessments ever undertaken of criminal justice systems servicing*

*Applicability. Federal Contractor Policies P.L. 93-638 Contracts "25 CFR PART 900" 107(a)*

*A. Contractor Policies Final Rule will apply this tribal consultation policy to all proposed policies that have tribal implications, to the greatest extent practicable and permitted by law. Based on a government-to-government relationship and in recognition of the uniqueness of each tribe, the primary focus for consultation activities is with individual tribes. The federal Contractor may serve, under the direction of the United States Of America, as the lead US Agency Indian Self-Determination and Education Assistance Contracting and Consulting officer for the implementation of this policy. Section 107 Contractor policies and procedures are from this policy*

*Self-Determination Education Act and Energy Self Determination Act 25 CFR Part 900 Congressional Act Final Rule*

*B. Comment: Policy Must Address Confidentiality of Tribal Interests. One commented, citing Pueblo of Sandia v United States, 50 F.3d 856, 861-62 (10th Cir. 1995), stated that it is critical to engage in tribal consultation in a manner that exhibits sensitivity to and respect for tribal confidentiality concerns regarding cultural, religious, political, and other inter-tribal affairs.*

*C. Executive Order 13175 (65 FR 67249, published November 9, 2000) recognizes the right of Indian tribes to self government and supports tribal sovereignty and self-determination. Among other things, it requires that agencies have an accountable process to ensure meaningful and timely input by tribal officials in developing policies that have tribal implications. On November 5, 2009, President Obama reaffirmed the M-10-33 government-to-government relationship between the Federal Government and Indian tribal governments in a White House memorandum that acknowledges that Indian tribes exercise inherent sovereign powers over their members and territory. The November 5, 2009, memorandum also acknowledged that the United States will continue to work with Indian tribes on a government-to-*

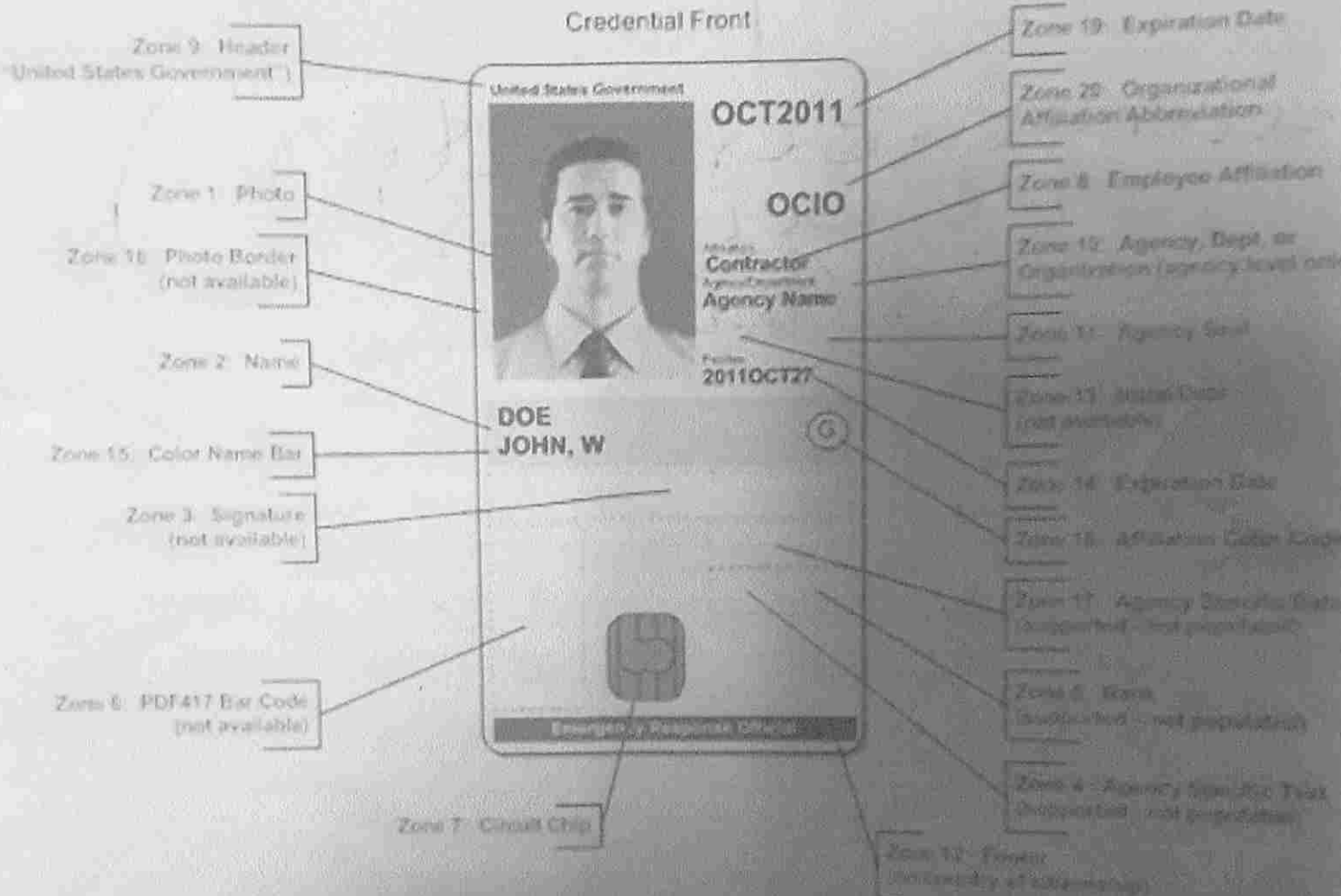

This document constitutes an Interagency Agreement (IA) with the Managed Service Office (MSO) and the (client agency name) which governs their relationship in work to be performed by the Managed Service Office for the client. The IA identifies the client's bona fide need.

**1.1 Amendment of Agreement**

This IA can only be modified by mutual agreement between the Managed Service Office and the client in the form of a formal Interagency Agreement Amendment (IAA).

**1.1.1 Recurring Services**

The MSO will provide FIPS 201 compliant services such as enrollment, issuance, card printing, PKI certificates, card finalization, and maintenance of identity accounts. Products and services available may include but are not limited to the following:

- PIV II Credentials with or without 125MHz coil
- PIV-I Credentials
- Monthly Identity Account maintenance
- Replacement cards
- Activation Station – maintenance/annual
- Configured PIV II test card
- Expedited Handling
- Agency adhoc reports
- Technical support services

Pricing of specific services will be based on the latest MSO schedule of pricing. Customer billings will be generated and processed on a monthly basis.

**1.1.2 Specific project**

If this IA is used in support of specific projects or tasks that go beyond the Recurring Services described in section 1.1.1, an Amendment shall not be used to extend or modify the client requirement(s). Rather, the process outlined in sections 1.1.2.1 and 1.1.2.2 shall be followed. If an amendment is required (e.g., in the case of a change of scope), all outstanding Projects under the original IA will continue in force unless explicitly canceled or modified by the amended IA.

**1.1.2.1 Project Plans**

The specifics of the work to be performed under this Agreement to meet the client's identified requirement(s) can be contained in one project or multiple sub-projects or accounts issued under this IA. Each sub-project or account will include the detailed specification of key deliverables to be produced; a schedule for these deliverables and for other critical milestones of significance to the client; the total estimated cost for that sub-project; specification of materials, data, and other forms of support from the client required by the MSO; and security requirements.

All projects, sub-projects, or accounts that are or become part of this Agreement are in support of the requirements in Part I and are subject to the limitations in scope identified in Part I, Box 10 of this IA agreement. Projects or sub-projects are incorporated as part of the IA in Part II of the IA coversheet.

**1.1.2.2 Project Element Change Notices**

A Project Change Notice (PCN) will be required to change the statement of work or to revise cost estimates. In no case will a PCN be issued that is outside the scope of the requirements established in this IA.

**1.2 Period of Performance**

This IA serves as both a service level agreement (SLA) and initial obligation of funding. The SLA portion of this IA shall be good for five (5) years from date of initial signature unless earlier modified by agreement between parties. The period of performance of the funding portion will be designated by the customer agency. *Tribal Nations*

### **1.4 Contractor Support**

The MSO has contracts with contractors to support MSO's clients. The MSO will assume full responsibility for:

### **1.5 Procurement Sensitivity**

The client understands that the contents of this IA and any related Interagency Agreement Amendments (IAAs), may be **procurement sensitive** and certifies that, to the extent permitted by law, (1) the contents of this IA and related IAAs will not be disclosed, published, divulged, released, or made known, in any manner or to any extent, to any individual other than an appropriate or authorized Government employee; and (2) such contents will be handled under the client's directives and policies governing the disclosure of **procurement sensitive** information.

### **1.6 Confidentiality and Freedom of Information Act Requests**

The MSO's policy is to maintain strict confidentiality with its clients. The fact that an agreement has been executed between the MSO and a client is considered public information. The general requirements and objectives addressed in that agreement are considered public information. The MSO's position regarding the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) requests made to the MSO is:

- The MSO will not release, to outside parties, reports or other documents produced as deliverables under our Agreement with the client. Instead, we will refer such requests to the agency with which we have the Agreement. We believe that referring the request to client agencies significantly improves the ability of the Government to determine releasability.
- The MSO will release copies of agreements between the MSO and the client agency, but will delete dollar amounts and any specific task descriptions that could provide a private firm an unfair competitive advantage if appropriate pursuant to FOIA Exemption 4.

### **1.7 Security**

#### **1.7.1 Security - Personnel**

The MSO personnel and contractors assigned to this project may require access to classified information as indicated in each Project. Clients should specify special security requirements as early as possible to enable coordination with appropriate security offices.

#### **1.7.2 Security – Network connectivity and Client Agency Practices**

An Interconnection Security Agreement, if applicable, will be formulated and negotiated under separate cover, signed by the responsible representatives of GSA and the client agency. In addition, MSO clients will adhere to the GSA HSPD-12 Shared Services Solution Registration Practices Statement.

#### **1.7.3 Security – Information in Identifiable Form**

Information in identifiable form (personal data) provided by the client to the MSO will be secured in accordance with the MSO's relevant Privacy Impact Assessment.

### **1.8 Funding**

#### **1.8.1 Acquisition Services Fund**

The MSO derives its financing from the Acquisition Services Fund, a revolving fund established under the authority of 40 U.S.C. 321. The MSO services provided under this Agreement are governed by 40 U.S.C. 501 rather than the Economy Act. The existence of a defined requirement (bona fide need) at the time this IA is executed forms the basis for the incurring and recording of a financial obligation on the part of the client. This obligation likely remains in force across fiscal year boundaries until the specified services are delivered or the Agreement is rescinded by the signatories.
